Comments and recommendations made by the inspection team as a result of the inspection	<p>Following a fall the nursing staff documents on the incident form that the G.P had been informed. We recommend that the nursing staff documents on the incident form the name of the GP that was informed, and the date and time informed.</p> <p>Currently the nursing staff document on the incident form if the fall was witnessed or not witnessed. When a fall is witnessed we recommend that the witness documents what was observed at the time of the fall, for example it there were any environmental factors that may have contributed to the fall .We recommend that the nursing staff document on the incident form what the resident was doing at the time of the fall, for example getting up from the chair in the bedroom/dining room/ walking from the bathroom etc.The analysis of this information should be documented in the residents care plan as applicable in the format of preventable measures which aim to reduce the risk of a reoccurrence.</p> <p>The Nursing Home Inspectorate recommend that the Person in Charge in conjunction with the staff develop and implement a policy on confused and wandering residents.</p>	Recommendations
